Fall 2018 CHBI Online Application is Open

The application process for CHBI has been simplified. Prospective students can now use the regular Camper / Payment link on www.CampHorizon.org or the link on www.CHBI.us. The form is brief and easy to complete. Then under "paid activities" they can choose the classes offered in the fall. No payment is needed immediately. Enrolling now will alert the committee to the amount of interest for the fall term. We do ask that a deposit of \$100 be made by July 7 to confirm your commitment.

The committee met twice recently to work on the curriculum for the fall and to work out other details. Among the changes is that each class will be two semester hours. This is based on 3 hours x 10 weeks of classroom work (which is equal to 2 hours x 15 weeks).

The committee has determined that we must have at least four students in each class to cover the cost of administering the program. It is important that interested students complete the online enrollment now!

Camp Horizon Internships

Our 2017-2018 intern (Naomi Roys) is graduating from CHBI this summer. We would like to have one or two interns beginning in the fall.

The Camp Horizon intern(s) will study at CHBI, be active in a local fellowship/assembly, and live at Camp Horizon from September through May.

Daily Summer Schedule Update

The Summer Planning team, including directors and speakers, met to finalize plans for 2018 and to plan ahead for 2019. The only major change was an increased time period each morning for individual devotions.

We tried online activity scheduling in 2017. We are returning to the classic Camp Horizon activity scheduling this year. Campers choose their four activities on Sunday afternoon. The only activity that needs to be scheduled prior to arrival is waterskiing / tubing.

There is still room in each week of camp. The themes are now posted on our website and directors are working on a shirt design for their week. An email is set to be sent about two weeks before each week of camp with information on what to bring, how to send an email message to your camper, and the theme for the week.

REGISTER NOW!

In recent years it has become increasingly common for registrations to increase in the days before camp begins. If you are waiting to register, or complete registration, there are a few things to consider.

- If you submit an online registration without completing the required online forms or making a deposit, the application is marked as “not confirmed”.
- Even though you may feel like you have “registered”, as long as the application is “not confirmed” the camper cannot be placed in a cabin and does not appear on reports of registered campers. The automatic invoice email shows them as “enrolled”.
- T-Shirts must be ordered about 14 days before the start of each camp program. Late registrations including “enrolled” or “not confirmed” campers that register after that deadline will not receive the shirt being printed for that week of camp.



Paper Camper Applications

We have not printed applications for a few years. However, there are some families that do not have internet access or have their camper’s online information completed by someone else. Paper applications are now available to download or can be mailed on request. This provides a signature page for those that cannot do this online.

South Florida Van Transportation

Camp Horizon has assumed the responsibility for recruiting drivers and renting vans to transport campers from Pembroke Pines to Camp Horizon and back. There is one stop at Palm Beach Gardens. For over two decades the brethren of Boulevard Bible Chapel have handled transportation and subsidized the costs. We thank them and their many volunteer drivers for their years of service.

Many of the drivers will be the same folks that have been driving for the past few years. The van drivers are being screened the same as our summer staff (fingerprinting). The cost has increased (\$20 each direction / \$40 round trip) but this still does not reflect the full amount required to provide this service. Camper Assistance is not provided for the van.
