Wisdom

146 friends of camp have shopped with Amazon Smile. Our most recent distribution was \$127.34. These funds are used for Camper Assistance. Since using this program, \$1,142.52 has been donated by people making one small change to their online shopping.

CAMP PROJECTS 2019

1976 was the first summer at this location. The original buildings included eight cabins and the dining hall. A lot has changed in 42 years, but not the propane lines or the windows.

PROPANE & WATER HEATER UPGRADE



The original propane lines and regulators were no longer up to current code. We ran new lines and regulators to the original buildings. Then, the aging water heaters flunked the leak test. So, we replaced them with tankless systems (like the new cabins). This also put all of the propane on the outside of the buildings.

This is an upgrade in both safety and practical use. Campers will no longer run out of hot water getting cleaned up for banquet night!

Cost of Propane Project: \$10,280

CABIN WINDOW UPGRADE

Many of the original windows would not stay open and some would even fall out. The mechanisms were completely worn out.

All original cabin windows (including the bathrooms) were replaced with energy efficient double-pane windows.



All curtains were replaced as well.



Cost of Windows & Doors Project: \$17,000

CABIN DOOR UPGRADE

This project has been on the list for a while. The original cabins were built with only one door. Now all of the original cabins have a side exit door.



These doors are locked to the outside and have safety bars that cannot be locked on the inside. We added a little new paint, seam caulking, and moldings. **The old cabins look like new again!**



Total cost per Cabin: \$3,410 (\$6,420 / building)
